FGD alum launches online service to prepare documentation in amicable separations

Former Farrar Gesini Dunn lawyer Siobhan Mullins launched SeparateTogether in May this year, targeting separating couples who have reached agreement and want to formalise it in an fast, easy and affordable way.

For as little as \$550, SeparateTogether will draft legally binding agreements to tie off the property or parenting aspects of a relationship breakdown.

Mullins identified a need in the market for affordable, easily accessible, quality, family law legal services. Her

practice is available online through telephone and Skype, and handles the 'low complexity' matters that could be prohibitively expensive if pursued through a traditional law firm.

While SeparateTogether does offer a Collaborative Law service for couples who have not yet reached agreement, their primary market is low-value, low-complexity matters where both parties already know what they want. Through efficient online processes, they aim to deliver their service at a price beyond the reach of a conventional lawyer.

With the business still in its infancy, it is too early to tell whether there is sufficient volume in the market to justify such low prices, but we think it's only a matter of time until all firms offer some sort of online engagement.

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
